Photography Museum. In three galleries, the museum displays the artistic and technical diversity of photography, including the most recent developments. A new 2,000m² extension has made it the largest photography museum in Europe.

Le Bois du Cazier. On 8 August 1956, this coal mine was the site of the worst mining disaster in Belgian history. Today, there is a memorial to the tragedy at the site, as well as a museum of the Industrial Revolution and a Glass museum with collections which trace the history of glass from its origins to the present day.

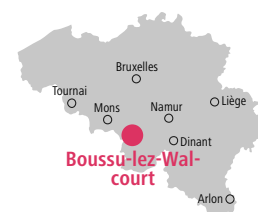

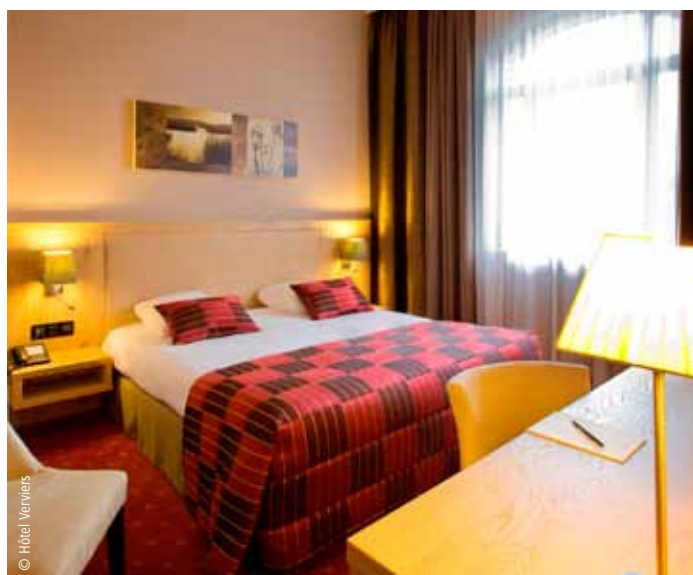

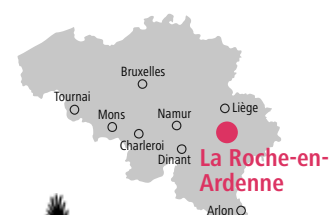

Half an hour from the centre of Brussels, the Hergé Museum is just waiting to be discovered. A bold and strikingly beautiful piece of architecture, the Hergé Museum houses a rich, colourful and seemingly boundless artistic heritage, a testimony to one of the greatest strip-cartoon artists and authors of all time.

You must have already heard of Hergé, the creator of Tintin and Snowy; now you can find out all about the father of European strip-cartoons, a talented artist in many fields. Hergé the illustrator, graphic designer, painter and storyteller: there is so much to discover about the man who created an entire genre of entertainment.
